DIFFERENTIAL DIAGNOSIS FOR PHYSICAL THERAPISTS: ROCE 5703

Course Length: 15 hours

CEUs Awarded: 1.5 CEUs

Overview:

The course covers the principles and methods of clinical screening in physical therapy practice and briefly summarizes diagnostic imaging, laboratory testing, and other medical diagnostic procedures. A basic format for musculoskeletal, neuromuscular, integumentary and cardiopulmonary screening in physical therapy will be presented, with a focus on differential diagnosis within the scope of physical therapy practice. The course also addresses how the physical therapist role interfaces with the physician role.
