## INTRODUCTION TO RADIOLOGY FOR THE HEALTHCARE PROFESSIONAL: ROCE 5702

**Course Length:** Self-paced, 15 modules

**CEUs Awarded:** 1.5 CEUs (15 contact hours)

The American Physical Therapy Association (APTA) states, "Class I acceptable continuing competence evidence shall be: Home study courses or courses offered through electronic media approved by recognized health-related organizations or accredited physical therapy educational institutions that include objectives and verification or satisfactory completion."

**Overview:** This course focuses on the basic principles and interpretation of radiographs as they apply to physical therapists and other healthcare professionals. The course provides an understanding of the basic physics of imaging, and the viewing and interpretation of films. The course will provide an opportunity to review images of the spine and upper and lower extremity joints. Radiographic anatomy and interpretation will be correlated to the clinical setting through case studies. The course also introduces other types of imaging including magnetic resonance imaging.

According to the American Physical Therapy Association, the professional training and expertise which characterize physical therapists has been recognized by 46 states and the District of Columbia. These states have removed the out-dated provisions requiring a referral by a physician from their statutes and have given patients direct access to the services provided by physical therapists.

This course prepares physical therapists with an understanding of radiology so that they can effectively evaluate and treat patients in the arena of direct access.

**Target Audience:** Physical therapists, occupational therapists and other healthcare professionals interested in broadening their understanding of radiology and improving the care of their patients in various clinical settings.

**Career Outlook and Benefits:** All states regulate the practice of physical therapy. Eligibility requirements vary by state. This course should meet a state's continuing education requirement as a condition of maintaining licensure.

According to the US Department of Labor, Bureau of Labor Statistics, job opportunities for physical therapists should be particularly good in acute hospital, skilled nursing and orthopedic settings, where the elderly are most often treated. Job prospects should be especially favorable in rural areas as many physical therapists tend to cluster in highly populated urban and suburban areas.
