e-Rate Terms and Conditions for Online Students Residing Out of State

- The e-Rate is available to students enrolled at Board of Regents institutions, who are classified as non-residents of Tennessee and who are enrolled exclusively in online courses.
- To qualify for an e-Rate, students must meet all institution admission requirements and must be verified as an online, out-of-state student enrolled exclusively in courses delivered online by a procedure documented by the institution.
- Students enrolled in any type courses other than online (on-ground, tele-course, distance education, etc.) will not be eligible for the e-Rate and will instead incur traditional non-resident fees and charges. Students who enroll in both online courses and other type courses and subsequently drop the other type courses will not then become eligible for the e-Rate.
